Discussion regarding survey:

- Nancy Fincke: Storypark is a tool that we need to understand more and establish what the expectations are. Should it be more of a dialogue? Who reads it? Readership has decreased from sept to now. Teachers put a lot of time into this, so it's hard to see the numbers going down. How many posts should you be doing? I feel it is worth giving it another year. We could establish minimums and maximums since the variability has

created some tension. There is also a question of whether it takes away from the planning time.

- Bryan Wynn: How do this year's results compare to the previous two years?
 - o Lauren O'Neill: It is pretty consistent. COVID was hard but glad to work through it together. Overall, teachers are happy to be here. They generally report feeling supported and having development opportunities
